## **BIR makes online business registration possible thru NewBizReg Portal**

Submission of application for business registration can now be done online!

Said contactless taxpayer transaction with the BIR is made possible through the recently-launched BIR New Business Registration (NewBizReg) Portal, an alternative option for taxpayers to safely and conveniently submit their applications for business registration to the concerned BIR Revenue District Office (RDO) through the portal.

The NewBizReg is available to both individual and non-individual business taxpayers, particularly sole proprietors, professionals, mixed income earners; corporations, partnerships; cooperatives, associations and other non-individuals.

"This NewBizReg Portal is the recent addition to our growing list of electronic services under the Bureau's Digital Transformation Program. Our goal is to continuously expand the types of transactions our taxpayers can carry out online 24/7 and without physical contact with revenue personnel. This way, we in the Bureau will be able to help curb the spread of Corona virus, as well as provide the taxpaying public with innovative, satisfying experience they deserve," Commissioner Caesar R. Dulay said.

To successfully register a business through NewBizReg, the applicant will have to email the application together with the complete documentary requirements including the payment of P500.00 registration fee and P30.00 loose Documentary Stamp Tax through any of the electronic payment channels of the Bureau.

For the Bureau to determine the applicable tax filing and obligations, taxpayer-applicant is likewise required to download and answer the tax type questionnaire and include this as attachment to mail application.

Taxpayer-applicant shall wait for an acknowledgement receipt of the application. The concerned Revenue District Office shall process the application within three (3) working days from the date of acknowledgement receipt. Upon approval of application, the taxpayer shall be scheduled for pick-up of Certificate of Registration and/or Authority to Print Receipt/Invoices.

The NewBizReg Portal is one of the many projects under the Elevating Taxpayer Experience and Innovating BIR Service Processes of the Digital Transformation Program, spearheaded by Assistant Commissioner Teresita M. Angeles of the Bureau's Client Support Service (CSS). It was launched simultaneously with the two (2) other projects of CSS, namely Contact Center Solution with Chatbot Module and Online Survey, in a virtual event via Zoom last June 1.
